Mercurey premier cru rouge

Clos du Roy (36 €) - 17,5

Issue de 50 ares de vignes de 60 ans très bien placées dans le Clos du Roy, la cuvée « phare » du domaine révèle une robe « noire », des arômes superbes de cerises, de mûres, de moka... Le vin est concentré, charnu, plein, long, racé, avec un beau potentiel de garde.

Respecter le fruit

Manuel Bautista exploite 55 ares dans le Clos du Roi, l'un des premiers crus les plus réputés de Mercurey. La vigne, âgée d'une quarantaine d'années, est plantée à mi-coteau, en exposition sud. Le vigneron en a tiré un vin comme il les aime, élégant et gorgé de fruit. « Nous avons vendangé à maturité juste, entre 12°5 et 13°, pour éviter de basculer dans les arômes confiturés. La vendange, entièrement égrappée, a été vinifiée pendant vingt-quatre jours, sans pigeage. L'élevage durera treize mois, en fûts de 228 litres, avec un quart de bois neufs » expose Manuel Bautista. Son Clos du Roi sera en vente à la fin de l'année.

Tupinier-Bautista, Vieilles Vignes 2020 Mercurey

The wine has a ruby color of medium intensity. The nose offers a certain concentration and a textured side, with gourmand and sweet touches of roasted fruits. It expresses notes of crushed morello cherry, roasted red cherry, wild blackberry, blueberry, blue plum and raspberry, associated with subtle notes of white pepper, licorice, a hint of menthol (peppermint, eucalyptus), a light note of toasted oak, chocolate and coffee in the background, as well as a touch of rose, which appears after aeration. The palate is tight, with a firm and tangy attack. It expresses notes of tart red cherry, bird cherry and cranberries with a good bitterness, raspberry and tart strawberry, as well as a fine menthol side (peppermint, fresh pine needles, liquorice), a hint of rose, as well as coffee and toast. The finish is chiseled, with a sharp acidity, notes of roasting and a good bitterness (coffee, bird cherry, cranberries) and a herbaceous hint of blackcurrant bud. Good persistence, the tannins are grippy and tight.

Tupinier-Bautista Les Vellées 2022 Mercurey Premier Cru

The wine has a pale ruby color. The nose is concentrated, gourmand, juicy and offers a beautiful fruity material that is a little sweet, even textured. It expresses notes of juicy morello cherry, red cherry, wild strawberry, redcurrant jelly and crushed raspberry, associated with slightly sweet floral aromas (peony, iris), sweet spices (a hint of vanilla, liquorice, nutmeg), toasted hazelnut and aromatic herbs (dried mint, fresh thyme in the background). The palate is juicy, enveloping and airy, with a good bitterness of cranberries and bird cherry and firm and gripping tannins (even slightly grainy). It expresses the flavors of morello cherry, sour red cherry, raspberry, red plum and sour strawberry, combined with herbal touches of peppermint, blackcurrant bud (in the background), liquorice and coffee. Good persistence in the mouth, with a salivating acidity and a beautiful freshness and a gourmet hint of dark chocolate with mint. The wine seems closed at the moment.

Score : 15+/20 (89-90/100)

Tupinier-Bautista Clos du Roy 2022 Mercurey Premier Cru

The wine has a medium-intensity ruby color. The nose is perfumed, juicy and gourmand, with distinct notes of sweet spices, toast and roasted herbs. It expresses notes of ripe morello cherry, roasted red cherry, crushed red currant, wild strawberry and raspberry coulis, combined with notes of toasted hazelnut, coffee and toasted wood (in the background), roasted bouquet garni, as well as a touch of freshness - the aromas of peppermint and crushed blackcurrant leaf, as well as a subtle touch of lilac in the background. The spiciness is precise, but delicate - we find in particular the aromas of toasted vanilla, liquorice, white pepper and ground nutmeg. The palate is fresh and airy, with well-structured and fine tannins, a salivating acidity and a good bitterness (coffee, bird cherry). It also expresses notes of fresh tangy fruits (blackcurrant, raspberry, red cherry, a hint of morello cherry), aromatic herbs (dried thyme and rosemary, peppermint), lilac, sweet spices (nutmeg, white pepper, liquorice) and roasting (toasted hazelnut). The finish is persistent, gourmet, slightly tight, but tasty, with notes of tangy red cherry and a good bitterness.

Tupinier-Bautista, Vieilles Vignes 2022 Mercurey

The wine has a ruby color of medium intensity. The nose offers gourmandise, juiciness, tanginess of the fruit, as well as a delicate minerality. It expresses notes of red cherry, raspberry, strawberry, a hint of cranberries and blueberry, as well as blueberry, violet in the background, white pepper, liquorice and a hint of pine needles. The palate is juicy, airy and fruity, with a good bitterness of cranberries and a lively acidity on the attack. It also expresses flavors of red cherry, raspberry, bird cherry and tangy strawberry, associated with notes of white pepper, liquorice, blueberry and a slight mineral hint on the persistence. The tannins are tight and slightly bitter. Good persistence, on the tangy side of the fruit, with a herbaceous hint of blackcurrant leaf.

Score : 14.75+/20 (89/100)

Tupinier-Bautista du Roy 2020 Mercurey Premier Cru

The wine has a ruby color of medium intensity. The nose is fruity and ripe, even with a slight maceration and roasted fruit side. It expresses notes of juicy morello cherry, fresh raspberry, strawberry, red cherry and red currant, black plum (after aeration), as well as a touch of goji berries in the background. We also find notes of roasting (toasted hazelnut, fresh almond), herbaceous freshness (fresh mint, a tangy hint of lemon thyme, fresh tobacco), sweet spices (fresh liquorice stick, Sichuan pepper, crushed coriander seeds, nutmeg), as well as a hint of lily and a delicate minerality (dry stone, limestone). The palate offers accuracy, a fine concentration, as well as a silky and juicy fruitiness, associated with a lively acidity. It expresses notes of sour red cherry, bitterness of bird cherry, dried cranberries, a hint of morello cherry, tangy strawberry and red currant. We also find the herbaceous side - dried mint, fresh tobacco, lemon thyme, rosemary, notes of sweet spices (licorice in the background, white pepper, crushed coriander seeds), as well as fresh almond and toasted hazelnut. The finish is persistent, concentrated and gourmet, on notes of ripe morello cherry, dried red cherry and a lively acidity, associated with a good bitterness.

Score : 15.5+/20 (91/100)

Tupinier-Bautista Clos du Roy 2021 Mercurey Premier Cru

The wine has a pale ruby color. The nose is reserved, fruity and tangy, but after aeration, it expresses the fine touches of roasted fruits. We also find notes of red cherry, raspberry, tangy strawberry, red currants, roasted red cherry, roasted raspberry, as well as dried mint, fresh thyme, blackcurrant leaf in the background, a hint of toasted hazelnut, licorice, white pepper and tobacco, as well as lily and violet in the background. The palate is tangy, straight, with freshness and accuracy. It expresses notes of tangy red cherry, strawberry, cranberries, bird cherry and red currants, associated with notes of peppermint, tobacco, licorice and white pepper. The finish is crisp, airy, fruity and tangy, with notes of tart red cherry and cranberries, as well as a touch of lily in the background and a good, slightly perceptible toasted bitterness. A pleasant herbaceous note of blackcurrant leaf and dried mint on the persistence. The tannins are very fine, but give the wine good structure. Nice acidity and liveliness.

Domaine Tupinier-Bautista 2023 Mercurey PC Les Vellées

Made with a mix of old vines planted in 1941 and young vines planted ten years ago, they all face due south. Impressively in this hyper-hot vintage, this wine has an easy-going freshness. Mixed citrus pulp and peel, white pepper spice and honeysuckle scent the nose and palate. A gentle vinosity layers on some light extract, helping to cement the flinty tones into the savory, solid finish.

Domaine Tupinier-Bautista 2023 Mercurey PC Clos du Roy

Quite in contrast to the lacy, elegant 2022, there are big shoulders here with fruit ripeness and depth to match. There is sinew, grip and flesh. Plus, a strongly flinty minerality suffuses every drop. Black plums, dry-aged red meat and dried mushroom are just the start. Leave this in the cellar a good while then watch the personality flourish!

Domaine Tupinier-Bautista 2023 Mercurey PC Les Vellées

Facing due south, this has the warmth and exuberance of the vintage on full display. Heady floral scents mix with rambunctious forest berries and scents of smoky char. Haute couture tannins and sappy freshness carry the woody undertones into the solid finish.

Domaine Tupinier-Bautista 2023 Mercurey PC En Sazenay

This is the first vintage with the old and the replanted portions of the vineyard, and what a joyous reunion it is! Black forest cake (mocha and cherries) meets rosebud highlights and a flash of minerality. Svelte and dignified with voluptuous fruit density, this is smartly hemmed in by sleek but coercing tannins and marked acidity.

Domaine Tupinier-Bautista, Vieilles Vignes, Mercurey, Burgundy, France 2023

Boasts perfumed, high-toned aromas of wild strawberries and rose petals. The texture is light and silky, with moderate persistence on the palate. The grapes are from 50-year-old vines; after careful sorting, they are gently fermented before ageing in cask, 50% new. This is perfect for current consumption, but has limited potential for ageing...

Dom Tupinier-Bautista, Sazenay Premier Cru 2023 Mercurey 16.5

Wintergreen, clotted cream and smoked oats. Thick-cream-yogurt sweetness and tang. A touch of basil-leaf anise. Lemon curd. Lots and lots in this full-bodied, satisfying wine to love. You could really sink into this. (TC)

Vines around 50–60 years old.

Friendly. A nice chock of easy-going tannins. Round fruit and smudgy, mouth-watering, a neat little core of pencil-shaving, pencil-lead minerality. (TC)

Dom Tupinier-Bautista, Les Chavances Vieilles Vignes 2023 Mercurey 16

50-year-old vines.

Quiet, comforting, soft-line wine but with ‘school-room’ minerality running through the middle. Strawberries and pepper and pencils. Fine tannins. Mouth-watering, thirst-quenching finish. (TC)

Drink 2025 – 2030

£250 per case of 12 ib Goedhuis Waddesdon

Dom Tupinier-Bautista, Sazenay Premier Cru 2023 Mercurey 16.5

Smells like lemons and oranges soaked in smoky strawberry juice. Lovely stony smokiness. Wispy tendrils of tannins turn firmer on the finish – feels well-bracketed. Touch of thyme. Good balance. (TC)

Drink 2026 – 2031

£290 per case of 12 ib Goedhuis Waddesdon

Dom Tupinier-Bautista, Le Clos du Roy Premier Cru 2023 Mercurey 16.5

Aged in oak, 25% new.

Mid crimson. Deeply fragrant, pure raspberry and cherry. More savoury on the palate, with tannins thickened a little – by the oak, I imagine. Light grip on the finish and needs time for the oak to recede. (JH)

Tupinier-Bautista, “Vieilles Vignes” 2023

Mercrey

The wine has a pale ruby color. The nose is concentrated, juicy, and fruity, with meaty notes and roasted red fruits at the opening, which disappear after aeration. It then expresses aromas of red cherry, cranberry, raspberry, as well as a fine spiciness (liquorice, cardamom, white pepper), a touch of blackcurrant leaf, as well as toast, wildflowers, and a sappy hint in the background. The palate is juicy, silky, with supple, barely perceptible tannins. The attack is sapid and fruity, with notes of morello cherry, raspberry, crushed blackcurrant, and ripe strawberry, combined with touches of toasted hazelnut, dried aromatic herbs (mint), as well as a hint of nutmeg and cornflower in the background. The finish is flavorful, tangy, and fruity, with mouthwatering acidity, a pleasant toasted bitterness, and good persistence and a more present tannic structure. Freshness, airiness, and accessibility in this wine.

Tupinier-Bautista “En Sazenay” 2023

Mercrey 1er Cru

The wine has a pale ruby color. The nose offers density, a delicious and ripe fruity material. It expresses notes of crushed blackcurrant, bigarreau cherry, red currant, strawberry and raspberry, associated with a precise mineral framework (limestone), which appears after aeration, notes of toasted hazelnut (even a more pronounced roasted side after contact with the air - toasted wood, coffee), herbaceous notes (dried mint, a hint of blackcurrant bud), liquorice, chocolate (even vanilla in the background) and blueberry. The palate is precise, fresh and tangy. On the attack, it expresses notes of ripe raspberry, blackcurrant, wild strawberry and red cherry, which are then complemented by spicy and toasted flavors (licorice, a hint of vanilla, nutmeg, toasted hazelnut, tangy dark chocolate), a herbaceous touch of fresh mint and blackcurrant bud, as well as blueberry and tanginess of blueberry. Tannins are finely tight and polished. The finish is tasty, quite persistent, with notes of ripe morello cherry, cocoa and a salivating acidity.

Tupinier-Bautista “Les Vellées” 2023

Mercrey 1er Cru

The wine has a pale ruby color. The nose is fragrant, chiseled and offers a lot of freshness in its herbaceous aromas and tangy fruits. It initially expresses notes of blackcurrant bud, peppermint, a limestone mineral framework, as well as raspberry, cranberries, red cherry and ripe strawberry. Then we find notes of licorice, chocolate in the background, peony and fresh rose, associated with a hint of nutmeg and toast. The palate is more closed on the attack, but then expresses notes of tangy red fruits (cranberries, red cherry, raspberry, crunchy strawberry), associated with a fine spicy and minty hint (liquorice, nutmeg, white pepper, wild mint), floral aromas (rose, violet), as well as a light touch of roasting (toasted hazelnut). The finish is savory, open, and fruity, with a pleasant hint of cranberry and toasted bitterness. Tannins are well-structured but fine. Good length with fruity gourmandise (red cherry, raspberry) and mouth-watering acidity.

Score : 15.5/20 (90-91/100)

Tupinier-Bautista “Clos du Roy” 2023

Mercrey 1er Cru

The wine has a pale ruby color. The nose offers concentration, even a certain density. The first nose is slightly smoky and meaty, but after aeration, it offers notes of ripe fruit, even jam. We find aromas of morello cherry, red cherry jam, fresh blackcurrant, wild raspberry, associated with a refreshing touch of blackcurrant bud, wild mint, as well as a hint of licorice, ground cumin in the background, toast, cranberry syrup, a sappy touch in the background and fresh flowers (rose, peony). The palate is precise, fruity and juicy. The attack expresses notes of morello cherry, red cherry, raspberry, ripe blackcurrant, which are then complemented by touches of liquorice, blackcurrant bud, toasted hazelnut, fresh wood in the background, as well as fresh flowers (violet, peony). Tannins are smooth and velvety. The finish is quite persistent, savory, fruity, with pleasant tangy notes of blackcurrant and a hint of chocolate and chocolate morello cherry on the persistence.

Mercurey premier cru rouge Clos du Roy 2022 (36 €) - 94

Nez intense, concentré, sur la cerise noire, la myrtille. La bouche est ample, pleine, charnue et s'étire en longueur pour finir sur des arômes de roses, de violettes. Les tanins crayeux, de qualité, accompagnent la salinité du vin.

Mercurey premier cru rouge Les Vellées 2022 (30 €) - 93

Nez de petits fruits noirs : cerises, mûres... Belle attaque en bouche, au touché soyeux. Le vin est bien équilibré entre la fraîcheur, un fruité juteux, de la matière, le tout avec une finale saline, en dentelle.

Mercurey rouge 2022 (18 €) - 92

Nez ouvert, expressif, de fruits confiturés. Une marmelade de fruits noirs qui s'accompagne de tanins solides, denses. Structure et maturité en harmonie, pour finir en longueur sur des notes réglissées.

Mercurey premier cru rouge En Sazenay 2022 (28 €) - 89

Nez de zan, réglisse, fruits noirs. Bouche aérienne, toute en finesse, en longueur, avec du fond et une belle finale saline, persistante. Le vin n'est pas en place, mais il a du potentiel !

Mercurey premier cru rouge En Sazenay 2023 (28 €) - 92

Nez puissant de fruits noirs concentrés, qui s'ouvre sur des notes épicées, fumées. La bouche est juteuse, charnue avec une finale saline, élégante, pure. Beau potentiel !

Mercurey premier cru blanc En Sazenay 2023 (30 €) - 92

Nez de pêches mûres, de mirabelles. La bouche est élégante, ronde, ample, suave avec une belle structure. Un beau vin souple, fruité sur la longueur.

Mercurey rouge vieilles vignes 2023 (18 €) - 89

Des vignes de plus de 60 ans pour cette cuvée de village. Nez intense de fruits frais : framboises, cerises... La bouche est ample, charnue, gourmande et bien équilibrée.

Mercurey premier cru rouge Clos du Roy 2023 (36 €) - 88
